

# POSTING NOTICES

● YOU ARE REQUIRED TO POST IN A CONSPICUOUS LOCATION  
A NOTICE ON WORKERS' COMPENSATION ●

Labor Code Section 3550 states that every employer shall post and keep posted in a conspicuous location frequented by employees, and where the notice may be easily read by employees during the hours of the workday, a notice which shall state the name of the current compensation insurance carrier of the employer, or when such is the fact, that the employer is self-insured, and who is responsible for claims adjustment.

Failure to post required notices is a misdemeanor and shall automatically permit the employee to be treated by his/her personal physician with respect to an injury occurring during that failure.

The posters are just one way of communicating to your employees the location of the pre-designated treatment facility. It also tells the employee who to contact at the fair to report their injury.
